



GETTING READY FOR YOUR PAINTERS

Prepping for Your East Dallas Painting Crew

A quick checklist to get your exterior ready before we arrive



Confirm HOA Approval & Notifications

If your neighborhood has an HOA, make sure any required color approvals or project notifications are submitted and confirmed before your appointment.



Confirm Your Appointment Details

Double-check your scheduled date, arrival window, and scope of work with your project coordinator.



Finalize Your Colors & Sheens

Confirm your chosen paint colors and finishes ahead of time so there's no delay once the crew arrives.



Clear Items Away From the House

Move patio furniture, grills, planters, and decorations away from the siding, trim, and doors.



Trim Back Landscaping

Cut back bushes, vines, and tree branches touching the house so the crew has clear access to every surface.



Secure Pets & Clear Play Areas

Keep pets inside or in a fenced area away from the work zone, and clear toys or play equipment nearby.



Clear Driveways & Access Points

Move vehicles out of the driveway and make sure gates and side-yard access are unlocked and clear.



Let Your Neighbors Know

A quick heads-up about trucks, ladders, and noise goes a long way – especially if we'll need access to a shared driveway or fence line.



Provide Access to Water & Power

Make sure an exterior outlet and hose bib are accessible for pressure washing and equipment.



Be Available for the Final Walkthrough

Plan to walk the exterior with the crew once work is complete so any touch-ups can be handled on the spot.
